The Sixteen Saints 5

St. Augustine was born November 13, 354 in Tagaste, Numidia now part of Algeria and died August 28, 430 in Hippo also in Algeria which was part of the Roman Empire. He was the bishop of Hippo from 396 to 430, one of the Latin Fathers of the Church and perhaps the most significant Christian thinker after St. Paul. His more important works are Confessions (c. 400) and The City of God (c. 413-426). His distinctive theological style shaped Latin Christianity in a way surpassed only by Scripture itself. He taught rhetoric in Carthage also in Algeria, then in Milan, Italy, and then returned to the town of his birth. At the age of 36, he was pressed into service as a junior clergyman in Hippo. He was made a presbyter (roughly a priest) in 391 and a bishop in 395 or 396. His writings are replete with quotations indicating his devotion to the Blessed Mother, e.g., "Then at the foot of the Cross He recognized her; yet, He had always known her. Even before He was born of her, He knew his Mother in her predestination. Before He, as God, created her from whom He would be created as man, he knew his Mother." One other popular quote of St. Augustine is: "For you [God] made us for yourself, and our hearts are restless until they find their rest in you." In his little window, we see St. Augustine holding a flaming heart. Could this be the restless heart seeking rest? May our hearts be restless always seeking rest in God.
